Fake News 🕲 Facts in Our Region

Philosophers have long recognized permeability between fact and fiction. New discoveries or fresh perspectives often turn fiction into fact and fact into fiction. In the 20th century, propaganda was the bête noire of reality, with Joseph Goebbels as its grandmaster in his Reich Ministry of Public Enlightenment and Propaganda under Adolf Hitler. Not to be outdone, the winning side's "good guys" – those who wrote history – were specialists at media houses such as the BBC whose work is quoted above.

The Institute of Regional Studies is organizing a three day conference on "Fake News and Facts in Our Region" from 24th-26th April, 2019. In response, scholars are coming from various countries, such as Afghanistan, Nepal, Morocco, USA and Turkey, to name a few, and from across Pakistan. This conference will examine the greater complexity of unraveling how individuals, institutions and whole nations manipulate fact to create credible fake news to their advantage and social media comes highly handy towards that end. Also examined will be the tension between fake news and fact being accepted/rejected by gullible/prejudiced audiences. This is in line with the buzzword that the 21st century is a post-truth era. The conference will highlight fake news and fact in the region where Pakistan is located, i.e., South and Southwest Asia, and big power influence in this area. The conference will be spread over three days and have seven sessions including the inaugural and the conclusive roundtable.
